ABOUT SEPIP 2023

The aim of the Smart Economic Planning and Industrial Policy (SEPIP) Conference is to assemble academicians, researchers, practitioners, regulators and policymakers from around the globe under one roof, to take account of the proceedings of the previous conference, level of implementation of various resolutions of the previous years and share results of academic studies, exchange views, share experiences and discuss fresh ideas on industrial policy, economic planning, and related contemporary tools to support economic development and national competitiveness.

SEPIP aims at developing a platform that enables participants:

- to discuss practical motivations for national development planning with those now emerging in the globalized world economy;
- to present real-world experiences in industrial policy and planning by international scholars with firsthand experience;
- to discuss new tools and approaches to development such as physical infrastructure planning, industrial policy and cluster policy.

The first conference, SEPIP 2014, was held on June 4, 2014 at Istanbul Commerce University, with the collaboration of the University of Virginia, the University of Parma, and the National University of Singapore. It attracted great interest and there was a wide range of atendance at the conference from academicians as well as policymakers and practitioners.

SEPIP 2023 will be held on October 12-13, 2023 at the International Balkan University (IBU), North Macedonia and/or online platform. The main theme of SEPIP 2023 will be Servicification of Manufacturing and Industrialization of Services, the sub-themes will be; Is software an industrial or a service product?; Al and circular economy; The use of artificial intelligence in manufacturing; New themes in industrial policy for a green development; Green industrial policies and the global transformation of climate politics; The economics of climate change; Geopolitical uncertainties and industry; Industrial policies and SME development.

SEPIP 2023 will strive to strenghthen the cooperation between developed and developing countries, public institutions and organizations, universities, and non-governmental organizations and the private sector. It will be a platform to bring all these actors together on a common ground.

- Authors should submit a brief biography with the final version of their accepted paper.



Skopje: The Capital of North Macedonia

Skopje is the capital of the Republic of Macedonia, the City that lies in the heart of the Balkan Peninsula, at the crossroad of important communications, a city with a 2000 years old tradition. Skopje is a modern city with population of almost one million and presents Macedonia's major political, economical, educational and cultural center. It continues to be a focus for new residents, economic development, construction and refurbishment. Skopje urban area extends across the Skopje valley for approximately 30 kilometers (18.75 mi) in width and comprises 10 municipalities.

Skopje also is a very attractive tourist destination with its fortress, cultural and historical monuments, archaeological sites, sport halls, caves in the canyon of the River Treska and Lake Matka and a health spa in the eastern part of the city.

Skopje is steadily becoming a vital regional route for international flight operators. The town with the beautiful quay of the Macedonian river "Vardar", the narrow streets in the Old Bazaar which is the biggest bazaar preserved in the Balkans today, the town is internationally famous for being the birthplace of Mother Teresa. He has blossomed into a thriving, stimulating city to explore, defining itself as an exciting tourist destination with the 1500 years old fortress Kale and monastery St. Pantelejmon with the fresco "Lamentation of Christ", with the first signs of the Renaissance, the Islamic monuments Sultan Murat's- Hjunkar Mosque, the Daut Pasha's bath.







- · Please provide 4 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.
- · Authors should submit a brief biography with the final version of their accepted paper.

Title Page

- · The title page should include:
- · The name(s) of the author(s)
- · The title of the paper
- The affiliation(s) of the author(s), i.e. institution, (department), city, (state), country
- · If address information is provided with the affiliation(s) it will also be published)
- For authors who are (temporarily) unaffiliated with an official institution, we will only present their city and country of residence, not their e-mail address unless specifically requested. However, their emails should still be provided in the title page.
- · A clear indication and an active e-mail address of the corresponding author and other authors
- · If available, the 16-digit ORCID of the author(s)

Body of the Article

Text Formatting

Manuscripts should be submitted in Word.

- Use 12-point Times Roman for text.
- · Use italics for emphasis.
- · Use the automatic page numbering function to number the pages.
- · Do not use field functions.
- · Use tab stops or other commands for indents, not the space bar.
- · Use the table function, not spreadsheets, to make tables.
- · Use the equation editor or MathType for equations.
- · Save your file in docx format (Word 2007 or higher) or doc format (older Word versions).
